Each year, River Oak assists 2,000 at-risk children and families through innovative programs that help children build skills to manage life's challenges. Our twelve programs touch the lives of 800 children and their families daily at four sites across the Greater Sacramento area. Services are provided in collaboration with Sacramento County Department of Health and Human Services', Division of Mental Health. River Oak is the only local nonprofit providing as many as five nationally-recognized programs proven by research to produce stable results for children and their families. In 2009, we plan on implementing two additional best practices.

River Oak has been recognized repeatedly for the excellence of our programs. In 2003 and 2006, we received Joint Commission accreditation for offering the best quality of care to children and their families. In 2007, the Child Abuse

Prevention Council honored River Oak for our leadership in and commitment to child abuse prevention and for implementing evidence-based practices. In 2008, River Oak received the "Exemplary Program of the Year" award from California Mental Health Advocates for Children and Youth for our leadership in delivering evidence-based practices.
