The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency was among eight winners of the 2010 Sacramento Workplace Excellence Leader awards.

The awards were presented for the eighth consecutive year by the Sacramento Area Human Resource Association in partnership with The Sacramento Bee.

The awards honor regional for-profit businesses, not-for-profit organizations and government agencies that "provide exceptional benefits, programs, training and workplaces that promote employee health, safety, advancement, diversity and security."
