## **Sacramento Monarchs and Wells Fargo to Unveil a Monarchs and Wells Fargo Do It Yourself (DIY) Teen Center at River Oak Center for Children**

**WHO:** The Sacramento Monarchs team, volunteers from Maloof Sports & Entertainment/Wells Fargo, youth from River Oak Youth Development and Education Center, world-renowned local artist David Garibaldi

**WHAT:** The Sacramento Monarchs team will join with volunteers from Wells Fargo and Maloof Sports & Entertainment to donate a Monarchs and Wells Fargo Do It Yourself (DIY) Teen Center to River Oak Youth Development and Education Center. The DIY Teen Center will provide outlets for teens to be engaged in positive activities, focusing on art, fashion, music and sports.

The donation includes computers, digital art workstations, a screen printing station, art tools and reading materials. The Center will be invigorated with a new decoration theme, "Inspire and Create," and a fresh coat of paint featuring inspirational quotes. Additionally, world-renowned local artist David Garibaldi will speak to the youth and answer questions.

The program at the development center is a collaborative with the Sacramento County Probation Department, the River Oak Center for Children and Quality Group Homes. At the site, juvenile probationers receive services including multidimensional counseling, pro-social education, therapeutic engagement, assessments, residential care and intensive community supervision by juvenile probation officers.
