Medi-Cal Eligibility Guide

Medi-Cal is California's Medicaid program, paid for with federal and state taxes. If you have been determined to qualify for full scope Medi-Cal, then you will receive Medi-Cal covered benefits at no cost to you.

Once a year all households must complete a renewal process to determine continued eligibility for Medi-Cal benefits. The purpose of the process is to report changes of address, family size, employment, taxable income and other expenses.

If you have been informed that your child no longer meets Medi-Cal Eligibility it is important to resolve this as soon as possible.

Your local County Welfare/Social Services Department manages Medi-Cal eligibility determinations. If you have questions contact:
